Acton Gardens Regeneration – Carisbrooke Court Demolition Update

From the 15 August 2024, Acton Gardens LLP will commence the demolition of Carisbrooke Court. This is a significant milestone in the regeneration of the Acton Gardens estate, making available land on the estate to bring forward new phases in the Acton Gardens masterplan. The stages of the demolition process are set out below along with estimated dates for each:

As you can see from the programme above, demolition of Carisbrooke Court is estimated to take approximately 4-5 months and will enable Acton Gardens LLP to begin the construction of a new phase of 236 new homes.

Minimising Impact of Demolition on Local Residents

We have been working closely with its demolition contractor over the past few months to ensure that the impact of the demolition works on local residents is minimised.

Through communication with residents at Acton Gardens and its neighbours, we appreciate that there are concerns in relation to noise, vibration, and dust. The demolition contractor will be monitoring noise and vibration levels throughout the demolition works to ensure they remain within agreed levels. Additionally, dust suppression equipment will be in operation during the demolition works, including wrapping the building in Monarflex. These dust precautions have recently been successfully used for the demolition of Frampton Court and Jerome Tower and have worked effectively to reduce the spread of dust.

Some asbestos needs to be removed from Carisbrooke Court as part of the demolition works. The asbestos removal will be carried out by licenced, accredited professionals in accordance with approved method statements to ensure the safety of both workers on site, and the local community.

Further progress updates on Carisbrooke Court, including the commencement of construction works, will be provided in future issues of the community newsletter.
